THE CURRICULUM

Chapel Road Primary School continues to provide a broad and balanced curriculum as detailed in the Northern Ireland Curriculum. As well as the core areas of learning the focus for all our teaching is on the development of skills and level of understanding. We assess pupils' progress in Communication, Using Mathematics and Using ICT. Daily procedures and policies are reviewed and updated where necessary to reflect best practice. Progress and development are shared with parents throughout the school year.

New initiatives we have successfully introduced include SUSTRANS Active Travel, ECO Schools and PATHS.



ADDITIONAL FUNDING IN THE YEAR 2021/22

The Department of Education recognised the challenges facing schools following the Covid-19 pandemic and the lockdowns where children were educated remotely. In response to this, all schools were awarded funding for ENGAGE and Healthy Happy Minds.

CHILD PROTECTION/SAFEGUARDING

Mrs Mc Callion is the Designated Teacher for Child Protection and Mrs Mc Cann is the Deputy Designated Teacher for Child Protection (in Mrs Conaghan' s absence). Mrs Mc Callion delivers refresher Child Protection training to all staff. Our Child Protection Policy is available to view on our school website and is shared with all new parents annually. It is also available in paper copy upon request. Child Protection procedures continue to be fully implemented in line with the Education Authority's guidelines. Safeguarding is a standing item on the agenda at BOG meetings.

PROVISION FOR PUPILS WITH SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS (SEN)

Mrs Bacheta is the Special Educational Needs Co-ordinator (SENCO). Mrs Bacheta's role is to lead and liaise with staff, parents and outside agencies in identifying children who have a special or additional educational need. The needs of the pupils are paramount. A range of support is provided by the class teacher, classroom assistants and where necessary outside agencies. The school also follows the Education Authority's referral system to access advice from the Educational Psychology Department. Children's progress is regularly monitored and evaluated. Data is analysed and appropriate targets are set. The staff are committed to providing all pupils with the best possible education, catering for the needs of every child and ensuring all children reach their full potential.

The school has a nominated Educational Psychologist (EA) and has access to advisory support and intervention when deemed necessary from other agencies such as

- RISE
- Social, Emotional and Behavioural Support Team
- CAMHS
- Action for Children
- EXTERN
- EA Literacy Service
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Autistic Spectrum Services

All pupils with an identified additional need (academic or behavioural) have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) which is developed and reviewed on a termly basis in consultation with the class teacher, pupil and his/her parents/guardians.

Moving Forward-The New Special Educational Needs Framework

SEN has been subject to changes in response to The Special Educational Needs & Disability Act (Northern Ireland) 2016. Schools have been awarded additional funding to allow the SENCO to implement these changes. Moving forward the SENCO will become known as the Learning Support Co-ordinator (LSC). The 5 Stages on the SEN Code of Practice has been reduced to 3 Stages. The Individual Educational Plan for pupils on the SEN Register will now be known as the Pupil Learning Profile. It is hoped that the Education Authority will provide the training and resources needed to realise these changes effectively. We are confident that Mrs Bacheta will continue to lead and manage this area and implement the changes by adopting a measured and efficient approach.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The on-going covid restrictions and social distancing requirements hindered some of our previous clubs. We were able to reintroduce MULTISPORTS mid-year and this was well received.

The 325 after school club has been a positive addition for working parents and provides a wraparound care for the children. The club provides time for the children to complete their homework and enjoy indoor and outdoor activities. An afternoon snack and drink are also provided. Feedback has been 100% positive. A special thank you to the staff who facilitate this club.

EXTENDED SCHOOL FACILITY-EARLY YEARS

The school was once again in receipt of additional monies through Extended Schools funding. We have used this funding, as in previous years, to facilitate an extended day for our Foundation Stage pupils. The aim is to target Literacy and Numeracy skills through a 'Learning through Play' approach. The children benefit from developing social skills and language through exploring and investigating a range of play scenarios. The club is called The Butterflies Club and has been a successful addition to our provision.

In a recent survey sent out to parents, the feedback received was 100% positive highlighting the excellent experiences of the children and the high-quality relationships and professionalism of the staff involved.

FOUNDATION STAGE INDOOR PLAY AREA

The cloakroom area outside the P1 and P2 classrooms has been transformed into a shared play area. The children use this area daily to learn through play activities. It is warm, stimulating and inviting. The boys and girls have enjoyed hours of learning and fun.



NEW OUTDOOR PLAY TRAIL

Year on year we are involved in continuous improvement in all areas of our provision. Our outdoor play equipment needed replacing, so we invested in a new and bigger outdoor play trail. We are very happy with the results and have enjoyed watching the children exploring and playing on it these past few days. The opportunity to improve physical skills whilst playing and having fun with your friends is always a bonus.
