The Friends of CRPS are hosting a disco on Thursday 13th February 2020 between 3pm to 4.30pm. Children can wear own clothes to school if they wish.

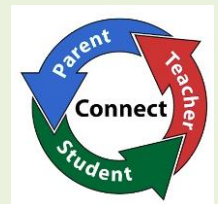
Entrance to disco is £2 which includes a tuck bag. We will do a head count before the disco so we can prepare the tuck bags in advance.

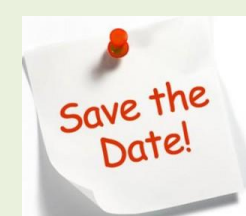
