HISTORIC BLUE PLAQUE

On Saturday 19th February 2022, The Ulster History Circle commemorated Redmond Friel, composer, arranger and church musician. A Historic Blue Plaque was erected on the front of our school building in recognition of his time at Chapel Road PS as a pupil, teacher and principal. In attendance was the Mayor, family members and former music pupil Phil Coulter who spoke about how Mr Friel had inspired him to follow a career in composition and music.

Mr Friel was an outstanding church musician, choral conductor and inspired arranger of Irish traditional melodies. His interest and love of Irish music spanned over 65 years and when he died in 1979, he left behind a musical legacy, which is unsurpassed. We were proud to accept the plaque and add another piece of history to our wonderful school.
