# **MORNING ARRANGEMENTS**

#### Early bird Club-8.15am

The school will now open at 8.15am to help make life easier for families in the morning. Mrs King will supervise the children in the hall.

#### Breakfast Club-8.30am

All pupils (P1-P7) can attend the Breakfast Club and must bring a donation for breakfast items.

#### Morning Supervision-8.30am

P1 and playgroup pupils will be supervised from 8.30am-9.00am in the P1 classroom. Mrs Mc Naught will supervise the children.

P2 will also now be supervised in their classroom from 8.30am-9.00am. Miss Mc Clelland will supervise the children.

P3-P7 pupils can wait quietly in the hall from 8.30am-9.00am where they will also be supervised by staff.

A short prayer assembly takes places at 8.55 am sharp. The pupils then filter to their classrooms at 9.00 am. It is important that children are not late for school.

# MISS SCHOOL MISS OUT-ATTENDANCE

Our Pupil Attendance Policy is guided by the Department of Education. Only pupils in school on time at 9.00am will be marked present so it is so important to arrive in school on time. Other attendance codes will apply after this time.

All absences must be accounted for so let us know if your child is sick or not attending school.

Mrs. Ashford in the office will assist you with any queries you may have.

## **END OF SCHOOL DAY ARRANGEMENTS**

All P1-P3 pupils should be collected by a responsible adult known to the pupil and staff. Any changes in home time arrangements should be made known to us via the office or in a written note to the teacher.

P3 and P4 pupils should be collected from the top playground. Please wait until the class teacher releases your child. P3 pupils are now big boys and girls so there is no need to come into the school to collect them. If you need to see the class teacher, please ask Mrs Ashford in the office to arrange this for you.


P5-P7 pupils will leave the school through the main reception and be released at the bottom of the main gates. This is to alleviate congestion at the top playground.

If your child is allowed to walk home a consent slip will be sent home. Please sign the consent slip provided and send into the class teacher as soon as possible.

#### Traffic

Please take the usual precautions regarding parking and reduce your speed. Keep your child/children close by at all times.

#### Shepherd's Glen Gate

The steps and the paths on the boundary between Shepherd's Glen and the school will be accessible to pupils from 8.15am and again at 2.00pm. The gate is usually closed shortly after 4.00pm every evening. Our caretaker (Paul) very kindly opens and closes this gate daily to allow quicker access to the school, however, the path and steps outside the school boundary are not school property and therefore anyone using this access is not covered by school insurance. The steps are quite steep so make sure you are happy with your child/children using them. Remind your child often about taking care and being safe.
