Dear Parent/Guardian

On behalf of the Governors and staff I am delighted to welcome you and your child/children back for another school year. We hope you and your family had a relaxing and enjoyable summer holiday. We would also like to welcome our new pupils and their families.

We are excited about the busy year ahead. The building works are going to plan and should be finished on schedule, around the beginning of October. Until then we have made all the necessary changes and are as always ready to begin the teaching and learning.

We will be involving the children in the building project through topic work so they will be exploring and investigating all aspects of the building site and how it works. The 'before and after' pictures are already very impressive. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us at the office.

The builders are aware of the need to allow parking for parents and will make the necessary adjustments during peak times. If you have any issues with this, please let us know so we can find a resolution.

We believe in maintaining close communication with parents/guardians and will try to ensure you are kept informed of all aspects of your child's education. We would encourage you to contact the school if you have any concerns or queries so that your questions can be answered quickly or where necessary an appointment can be arranged. As always it is important to talk to the class teacher in the first instance as issues are usually resolved much quicker this way.

As we get the school year off to a busy start it is important to share some important information relating to policies and procedures that are in place to ensure the safety and well-being of the whole school community. Please read this information carefully and keep for reference. Any additional information will follow where necessary.

MORNING ARRANGEMENTS

Early bird Club-8.15am

The school opens at 8.15am. Mrs King will supervise the children in the hall.

Breakfast Club-8.30am

All pupils (P1-P7) can attend the Breakfast Club and must bring a donation for breakfast items. Until the building works are complete breakfast will be served in the staffroom.

Morning Supervision-8.30am

<u>P1 pupils</u> will be supervised from 8.30am-9.00am in the P1 classroom. Mrs Mc Naught will supervise the children.

<u>P2 pupils</u> will also now be supervised in their classroom from 8.30am-9.00am. Miss Mc Clelland will supervise the children.

<u>P7 pupils</u> will go to their classrooms upstairs until the building works are complete. Miss Lynch will supervise the children.

<u>P3, P4, P5 and P6 pupils</u> will wait quietly in the hall from 8.30am-9.00am where they will also be supervised by staff.

A short prayer assembly takes places at 8.55 am sharp. The pupils then filter to their classrooms at 9.00 am. It is important that children are not late for school.

END OF SCHOOL DAY ARRANGEMENTS

<u>P1 and P2</u> children finish school daily at 2.00pm however, if you wish your child is welcome to attend our BUTTERFLIES CLUB-2.00-3.00PM. These arrangements will begin tomorrow Monday 2nd September 2019. <u>P4-P7 pupils</u> finish school at 3.00pm. (Please note no 3.00-4.00pm clubs in the first week)

All P1-P3 pupils should be collected by a responsible adult known to the pupil and staff. Any changes in home time arrangements should be made known to us via the office or in a written note to the teacher.

Until the building works are completed all pupils will be brought out to the infant reception playground. Please wait until the class teacher releases your child. P3 pupils are now big boys and girls so there is no need to come into the school to collect them. If you need to see the class teacher, please ask Mrs Ashford in the office to arrange this for you.

If your child has permission to walk home, please complete the consent slip and return to the class teacher as soon as possible.

AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS

<u>3.00-4.00pm after school clubs</u> will begin next week-9th September 2019. More information will go home this week.

<u>3.00-5.00pm after school club</u> will begin this week on Wednesday 4th September 2019. A letter will go home tomorrow if you wish to sign up for this club. If you finish work at 5.00pm and would like to avail of this club, please contact us.

MISS SCHOOL MISS OUT-ATTENDANCE

HEALTH AND SAFETY

<u>Traffic</u>

Please take the usual precautions regarding parking and reduce your speed. Keep your child/children close by at all times.

<u>Shepherd's Glen Gate</u>

The steps and the paths on the boundary between Shepherd's Glen and the school will be accessible to pupils from 8.15am and again at 2.00pm. The gate is usually closed shortly after 4.00pm every evening. Our caretaker (Paul) very kindly opens and closes this gate daily to allow quicker access to the school, however, the path and steps outside the school boundary are not school property and therefore anyone using this access is not covered by school insurance. The steps are quite steep so make sure you are happy with your child/children using them. Remind your child often about taking care and being safe.
